<b>Crescendo Pinot Grigio</b> <b>Italy</b> A clean, fresh and fruity wine with lots of citrus and ripe pear flavours. Dry and crisp with refreshing finish.	£5.70	£8.00	£23.00
<b>Sauvignon Blanc Reserva, Terra Vega</b> <b>Chile</b> A pronounced and herbaceous bouquet of green pepper and gooseberry accompanies subtle hints of passion fruit.	£5.70	£8.00	£23.00
<b>Dominio de la Fuente Verdejo, Organic</b> <b>Spain</b> A crisp, aromatic white wine, showing great purity of aromas. Bright, pale straw yellow, with intense, fresh notes of grass, fennel and white pepper.	£5.90	£8.40	£24.00
<b>Lua Nova Vinho Verde</b> <b>Portugal</b> This wine is fresh, zesty and zippy. On the nose there are notes of white flowers, and on the palate tropical and stone fruits.	£6.40	£9.00	£26.00

<b>Picpoul de Pinet Plo de l'Isabelle</b> <b>France</b> A snappy nose of lemon and lime fruit, with vibrant green apple. A racy wine with a lip-tingling finish.	£6.90	£9.90	£29.50
<b>Roberto Sarotto Gavi DOCG del Comune di Gavi</b> <b>Italy</b> Delicate floral blossom aromas with hints of pineapple, apricot and peach. The palate is fresh and vibrant, balanced with extra richness in texture from ageing on the fine lees.			£35.00
<b>Sancerre Blanc Duc Armand, Organic</b> <b>France</b> Elegant dry white wine, pale yellow colour, aromas of white flowers and green apple and refreshing citrus flavours.			£44.00
<b>Pouilly Fuissé Domaine Trouillet</b> <b>France</b> Domaine Trouillet is a small boutique estate in the Maconnais. Now in the hands of the third and fourth generation of the family, its specialism is Pouilly Fuisse. Trouillet's vineyards are on average 40-50 years old and the lower yields from this venerable vines produces complex, full-flavoured whites. With aromas of almond, hazelnut and citrus, supported by a peach, brioche and honey notes, this is Pouilly Fuisse at its best.			£48.00

<b>Crescendo White Zinfandel Rosé</b> <b>Italy</b> Elegant pink colour. Fresh strawberry and raspberry fruit flavours.	£5.70	£8.00	£23.00
<b>Nicolas Rouzet, Coteaux d'Aix en Provence</b> <b>France</b> A pale, delicate rosé, both fine and elegant with red berry notes. The palate is round and marked by strawberry, raspberry, redcurrant, and a hint of peppery spice.	£6.85	£9.70	£28.00
<b>Peyrassol 'Méditerranée' Organic Rosé, IGP Méditerranée</b> <b>France</b> A beautiful pale pink colour with clear bluish highlights. This expressive cuvée opens immediately with notes of red berries supported by delicate citrus fruit. A touch of refreshing greenness accompanies the palate, giving this lively, fresh wine a truly thirst-quenching character.	£7.30	£10.40	£30.00

## BUBBLES

**Apericena Prosecco**

**Italy**

Delicate and aromatic with fine bubbles. This wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear and an elegant zest.

**Nicolas Feuillatte 'Grande Réserve' Brut Champagne**

**France**

A step up from their original brut Champagne, it has more Chardonnay in the blend and uses a higher proportion of reserve wines, giving the winemaker even more possibilities to curate delicious flavour. It's aged for at least three years in their cellars, slowly developing complex flavours and a rich texture. The ideal wine to elevate any occasion - at fantastic value. Expect fresh notes of grapefruit, tangerine, plum and nectarine with a smooth, creamy finish.

**Oeil de Perdrix Rosé NV**

**France**

This needs no introduction. A crowd of wine critics has sung its praises, with The Telegraph's Victoria Moore calling it "a delight". It boasts elegant swathes of red cherry, raspberry and refined blossom notes that drift through its delicate mousse. It's pink Champagne at the top of its game.

**Veuve Clicquot Brut NV**

**France**

Founded by Madame Clicquot in 1772, Veuve Clicquot, the house that once entertained Napoleonic soldiers, is known as the 'Queen of Champagnes'. Aged for twice as long as is legally required and made from grapes plucked from the finest vineyards, it's as biscuity rich as they come.

## RED WINE

**The Old Gum Tree Shiraz**

**Australia**

This is a classic, fruit driven Shiraz with intense, ripe raspberry and cherry flavours with overtones of vanilla and spice.

**Gufetto Montepulciano d'Abruzzo**

**Italy**

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC is characterized by an intense ruby red colour and scents of red and black berries to the nose, as well as a green peppercorn spicy aroma. On the palate, it is tannic and complex.

**Merlot Reserva, Terra Vega**

**Chile**

The wine delivers a solid core of concentrated fruit, hinting at blackberry preserves and damson plums.

**Conde De Castile Rioja Crianza**

**Spain**

Full of black fruit with hints of cocoa, clove and cinnamon. Supple tannins tempered by lush sweet oak.

**Olivier Maurice Côtes du Rhône**

**France**

Attractive red berry nose with hints of spice. Lovely fruit entry on the palate with plenty of red and black berry flavours, overlaid with a hint of spice. Soft supple tannins and a lift of acidity give the wine length and complexity.

**Vista Plata Malbec**

**Argentina**

This big and bold Malbec leads with intense fruit. The oak gives a vanilla character and provides a serious backbone to this wine with velvety soft tannins.

**Mozzafiato Primitivo**

**Italy**

This Primitivo has a mouth-coating palate of dried prune, date and cherry, with notes of sweet spice and a lick of chocolate. Great structure from the good balance between the soft tannins and acidity.

**Fernlands Pinot Noir**

**New Zealand**

An elegant cocktail of black cherry, rose petals and cranberry is balanced by zippy acidity. With silky-soft tannins, it's a light sipper ideal for the warmer nights.

**Kanonkop Pinotage**

**South Africa**

In the lower slopes of Stellenbosch's Simonsberg Mountain, grapes are treated to an extended ripening season. You'll have a seriously hard time finding a better expression of Pinotage elsewhere. The Kadette is a palate of ripe red fruit, elegant tannins and a deluxe slather of mocha that Tim Atkin MW gave 92 points.
